



Canvas Instructor Guide

Step 1. Create your Direct Access Link


a. Log in to Canvas, locate your course, then navigate to the Settings page.



b. Locate your Electude Direct Access Link and drag it up to your Navigation




c. Your Electude Direct Access Link is now available in your Course Navigation.



Step 2: Directly Access Electude to create a Course and add Modules.


a. Click on the Electude Direct Access link in the Navigation Menu.



Here you have access to create courses, add modules to courses, and see student data. You can create custom courses in Electude or add the Modules directly to Canvas without adding them to a course. (See **Step 3.**)


The Direct Access Link is your Electude course builder link and is not visible to students

b. Create an Electude Course through Direct Access by clicking the Courses tab and then click the + under the Courses section.



c. Name your Course, add a Description, select your Course Level and click







d. Click on your Course name below.

e. Once your Course is selected, you can navigate to the Modules tab at the top of the Electude window and start adding Modules to your Electude Course.




f. Once in the Modules tab, find the Module you want to add and drag it to your Courses Tab. Make sure the right Course is selected when dragging and dropping your Module.




When you are finished building your course, Click the X in the top right to return to Canvas and proceed to **Step 3**.

Step 3: Add Modules to your Canvas Course


a. Navigate to the Modules tab in the Navigation Menu in Canvas.




b. Click the button and name your Module group Electude Modules in Canvas and click Add Module .




c. With the new Module created, click the + button next to your Module and select External Tools from the drop-down menu. Locate your Electude LTI link in the list below. (If there is no Electude link available, please contact your **Canvas** Administrator)




d. Click on the Deep Linking Electude tool, Electude will open in the Canvas window.




e. Click on the Courses tab in Electude and scroll down to the Modules you added in Step 2.




f. Click on the Module you want to import into Canvas, then click on the Module name in red.




g. Click Select as LTI tool



h. Click Add Item . Your Electude Module is now "Deep Linked" into your Canvas course.



i. Make sure to publish your Module Group and Module so they are available to students.



Repeat Step 3. To link the rest of your Electude Modules

Quick FAQ Guide

Q: How do students get enrolled in Electude from Canvas?

A: Once a student clicks on an Electude module in Canvas they are automatically enrolled in the Electude Course.

Q: Can I still access Electude Directly through the website once the integration for Canvas is complete?

A: No, we restrict direct access to the Electude website once the integration is in place for grade sync and single sign through Canvas.

Q: Can I access previous courses in Electude?

A: Yes, if you are unable to see other courses in Electude please contact your Electude admin or representative to enable this option.
