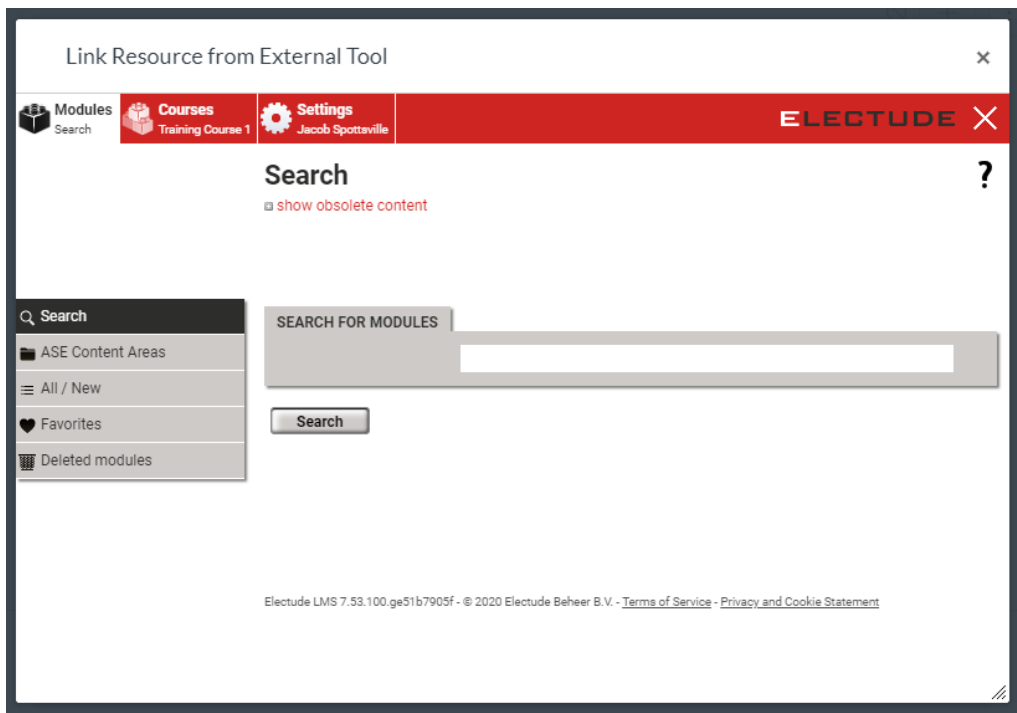
- b. Click the  button and name your Module group Electude Modules in Canvas and click .



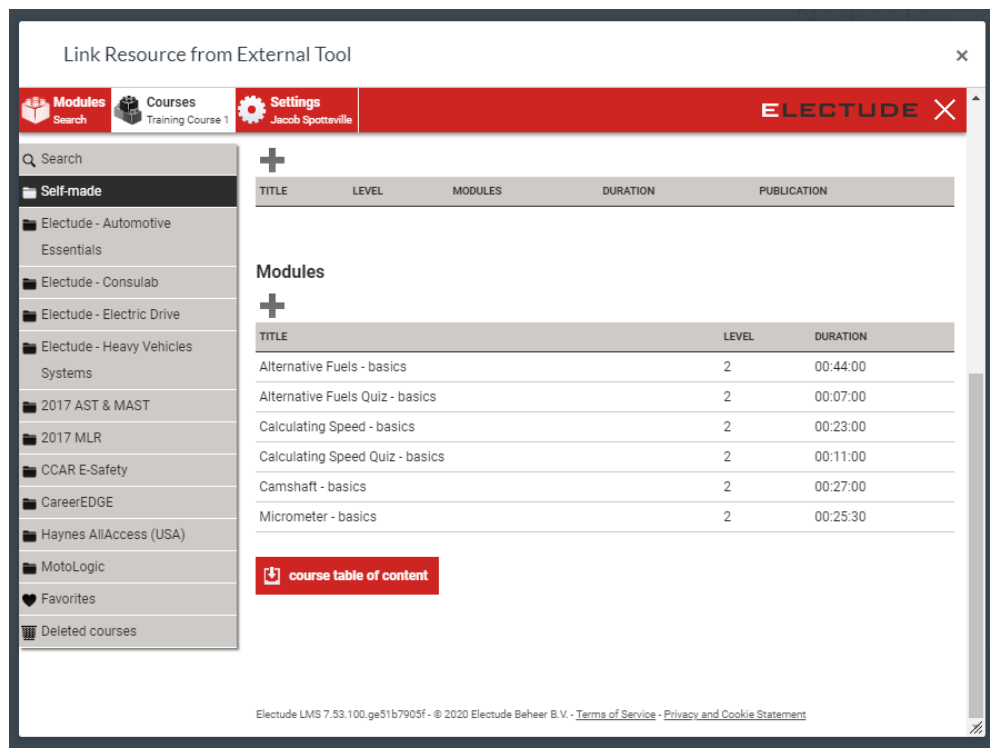

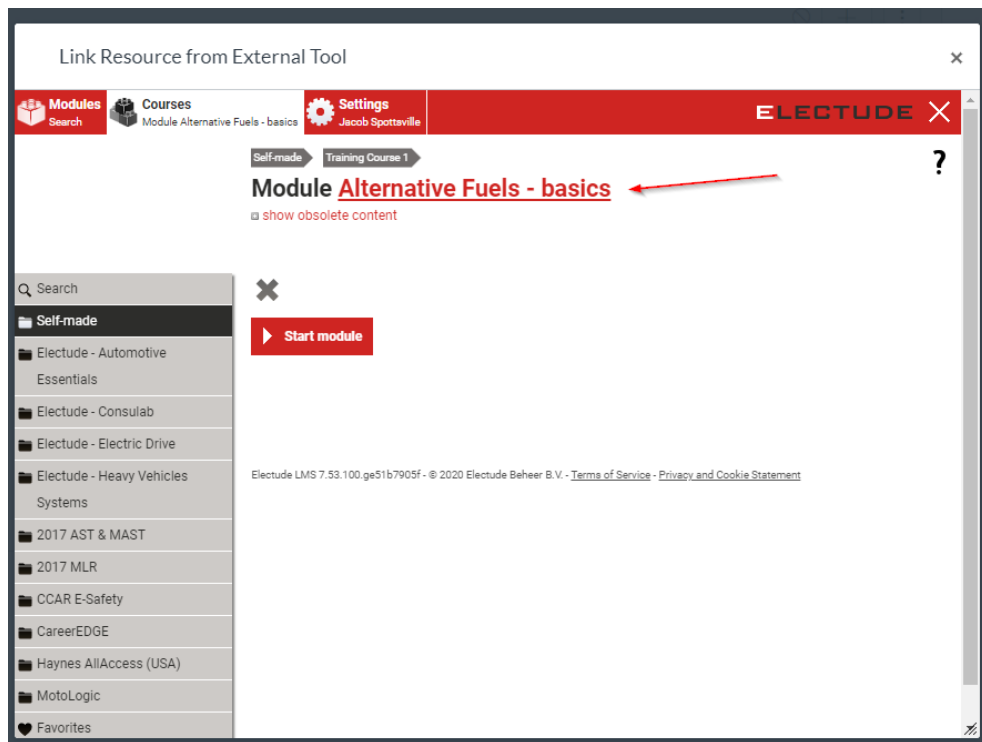
- d. Click on the Deep Linking Electude tool, Electude will open in the Canvas window.



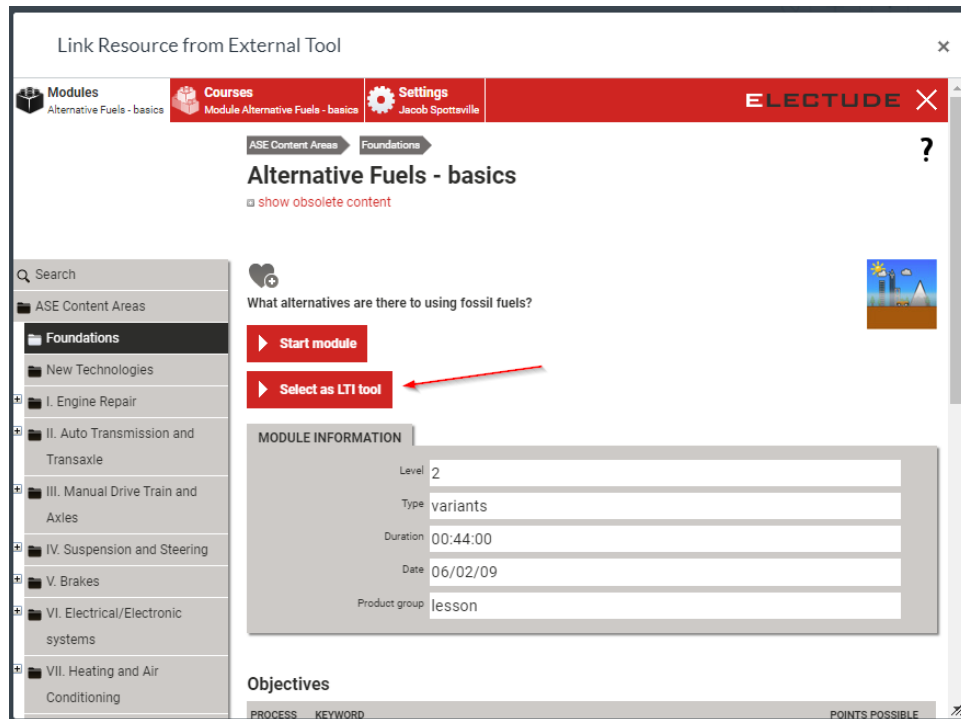
- e. Click on the Courses tab in Electude and scroll down to the Modules you added in Step 2.
